

Medicare ABN Letter

Dear ITR Client,

ITR Physical Therapy is not a participating provider with Medicare. This means that ITR does not have a medicare number. If Medicare is your primary insurance, then ITR can only see you for wellness sessions or for maintenance. We are happy to refer you to another clinic who accepts Medicare if you prefer. If you decide to be seen by ITR and Medicare is your primary insurance you cannot submit your claim for reimbursement. You will not receive an invoice with CPT or ICD-10 codes but for your wellness or maintenance session.

By signing this document you understand that Medicare will not pay for this treatment and you agree that:

ITR has not solicited me in any way. ITR offered to give me names of participating Medicare Providers but I asked ITR if I could still come to receive treatment here.

I understand that ITR is providing wellness or maintenance programs and not your traditional physical therapy treatments.

Medicare will not cover this treatment as I am not seeing a physician every 30 days

Medicare will not cover this treatment as I am being seen less than the typical 2-3 times a week frequency required by Medicare

Beneficiary Agreement:

Medicare traditionally considers one to two months of physical therapy as reasonable and customary and this maintenance program is longer than this interval

I agree to the terms as stated in the Medicare ABN and have been notified by my physical therapist that Medicare will deny payment for the above stated reasons. I agree to be personally responsible for the payment. Client Name Date
